ENROLLMENT TIMES AND LOCATION

- Returning families are encouraged to enroll online, through Skyward between the dates of July 15-31. New students and any returning families needing online help will attend a walk-in enrollment. For all grades, this will be held at one location:

Walk-In Enrollment: Central High School, 650 E Crawford
July 25 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO ENROLL FOR NEW STUDENTS

- New families will need to provide proof of student's identification. The following will be accepted as proof:
 - Birth certificate (hospital or official state copy); or
 - Copy of a court order placing the student in their custody; or
 - Certified high school transcript; or
 - Baptismal certificate
- New families, will need to provide proof of residence. The following will be accepted as proof:
 - Any current bill sent to a parent/legal guardian with name and address; or
 - Current tax statement; or
 - Current lease agreement; or
 - Current documents proving the purchase of residence
- New families must provide a copy of their student's immunization records.
- New families must provide a health physical completed by an approved health care provider within 12 months of the enrollment date

OTHER ITEMS WHICH MIGHT BE REQUIRED

- If participating in activities such as sports, cheerleading, marching band, dance, forensics, etc. student must have a Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) Physical Form completed each year, dated May 1st or later
- All students entering 6th grade or 9th grade will need a new physical
- Any updated immunization records may need to be provided
