Enrollment Information:

ACT Prep, Driver's Education, Computer Applications 1 & 2, Speech, Credit Recovery Courses

Sessions will be filled on a first-come first-served basis, and on the availability of staff.

Wednesday, May 23,

5:00pm-7:00pm at Central HS

Credit Recovery Courses, open ACT prep and enrichment sessions IF still available.

Note: Summer school classes do not count toward eligibility.

Fees:

Fees for all high school courses, other than Driver Education and ACT Prep., are \$110/semester credit.

A minimum payment of \$25/class must be made at the time of enrollment. The balance will be due by May 29, unless arrangements have been made with your school.

Cancellation of Enrollment:

If a student drops a course before May 29, a refund will be given. A \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. If a student drops after May 29, no refunds will be made.



Enrichment Courses and Credit Recovery

Session Times:

Session 1: 8:00 am—10:00 am, Monday - Friday

Session 2: 10:00 am—Noon, Monday - Friday

Daily attendance is required. Students who miss more than four days will be dropped from the program and will not be issued a refund.

Enrichment Courses:

These courses may be taken to fulfill the district's computer literacy or oral communications requirements. Completion, with a passing grade, will result in a 1/2 high school credit for each course.

A student may elect to take the course without receiving credit, but must declare no credit at the time of enrollment. *Any course taken for credit will receive a grade and be computed in the cumulative grade point average.*

- **Computer Applications 1**
- **Computer Applications 2** (prerequisite: Comp. App. 1)
- **Speech**

Driver Education and ACT Prep:
