- 5) Heartland has sustained the weekend food support program and as the 2021-22 year ended, we distributed 1,967 bags. With persistently high food prices, we don't expect to see a decline in this program anytime soon. This program is possible through funds awarded by the CHIP grant and other donations.
- 6) The Federal grant application approved was originally for \$120,000 less than the current year budget approval due to the enrollment reduction. After the grant application was submitted, the Regional Office requested we revise the budget application and utilize the funds to increase staff salaries. All staff received the approved district salary increase effective July 1 using the COLA and Quality funds received. All teacher assistants also received a job reclassification to increase hourly wages. Staff were recently notified of this additional salary increase. Starting teacher assistant hourly wage for 21-22 was \$12.14 per hour. Starting teacher assistant hourly wage for 22-23 will be \$13.50 per hour. This is an increase of 11.2%.
- 7) The Salina Parents as Teachers program has met all Essential Requirements for the 2021-2022 service year. The program moved from a provisional status to a compliance status, improving in many areas. The primary goal for the 2021-2022 was increasing visit frequency for families with two or more stressors. The strategies included monthly monitoring of home visit frequency, addressing each family's situation during reflective supervision, and creating strategies to complete the required number of visits over the entire year vs just focusing on one month at a time. The improvement has occurred with some support from the national PAT team, which helped in narrowing goals and implementing strategies and providing monthly virtual support meetings.
