For children, you may designate a pediatrician as the primary care provider.

You do not need prior authorization from Salina USD 305's Health Insurance/ Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas or from any other person (including a primary care provider) in order to obtain access to obstetrical or gynecological care from a health care professional in our network who specializes in obstetrics or gynecology. The health care professional, however, may be required to comply with certain procedures, including obtaining prior authorization for certain services, following a pre-approved treatment plan, or procedures for making referrals.
