

# Educational Goals: 1st Grade



Whether your child is on-site or off-site, it is important to have the same educational goals. The instructional activities your classroom teacher plans for your child will be different, but the learning outcomes will be the same. When on-site, the classroom teacher will facilitate in-person learning through whole class and small group instruction. When off-site, your child will be learning the same content through technology-enhanced and independent learning activities planned by the classroom teacher. The off-site instructional activities will be an extension of in-class learning and will not require you to “teach” your child new skills. If your child is struggling with the off-site learning activities, please contact your child’s classroom teacher.

Subject	On-Site	Off-Site
Morning Meeting	1 <sup>st</sup> graders will have an activity to build communication skills, the classroom community, and social-emotional learning.	Students will be given a social emotional prompt and will respond through speaking, drawing or writing.
Reading	The teacher will provide whole class and small group instruction. Reading class will include reading skills, vocabulary, and phonics mini lessons. The teacher will read aloud to students and discuss the text to increase comprehension. Students will use district reading units to improve comprehension and apply mini lesson skills.	The teacher will provide reading instruction for reading skills, vocabulary, and phonics through online resources. A link to an online read aloud could be provided through the Google Classroom page. Students will use district reading units to improve comprehension and apply mini lesson skills.
Writing	First Strokes Handwriting Program	The teacher will provide writing practice sheets and writing formation practice sheets. Students will also respond to writing prompts.
Math	The teacher will provide a lesson to the whole class along with small-group and individual support for students who need additional instruction. Students who have mastered the lesson will have enrichment opportunities.	The teacher will provide instruction using video or online resources. Students will use district-approved websites and hands-on math activities to learn and practice skills.
Specials (Social Studies, Science, PE, Music, and Art)	Students will receive specials while they are on-site with safety protocols in place.	Teachers will provide a link to lessons on Google Classroom.
Recess	Students will participate in recess while they are on-site with safety protocols in place.	Students will do at-home physical activity.
