The Career Fair will be conducted in two parts, virtual and in-person. The virtual Career Fair will consist of short video submissions or questionnaires by participants (~5-7 minutes), detailing aspects of the career including the following: education requirements, opportunities for advancement, requirements of the job, how the profession serves a community, and how the profession is unique from others.
